## **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/CARERS**

### ***Essex Redbacks Baseball Club***

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- All must obey the club rules where applicable to parents or carers.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgments.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide participants to accept responsibility for their own performance and behavior.
- Abide by the clubs safety policy. All Parents / Carers should provide their child with a Protective box/cup as appropriate (and gum shield if preferred for batting) for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
